
# **BUILDING MATERIAL PRICE INDEX September QUARTER 2023**

[Base: Average 4 Quarters 2014 = 100.0]

The All Items Building Material Price Index (BMPI) for the September quarter of 2023 stood at 129.2. The index is compared to those of earlier periods to gauge the price movements of a representative list of Building Materials.


The All Items BMPI for the September quarter of 2023 registered an increase of 1.2 percent over the June quarter of 2023.
