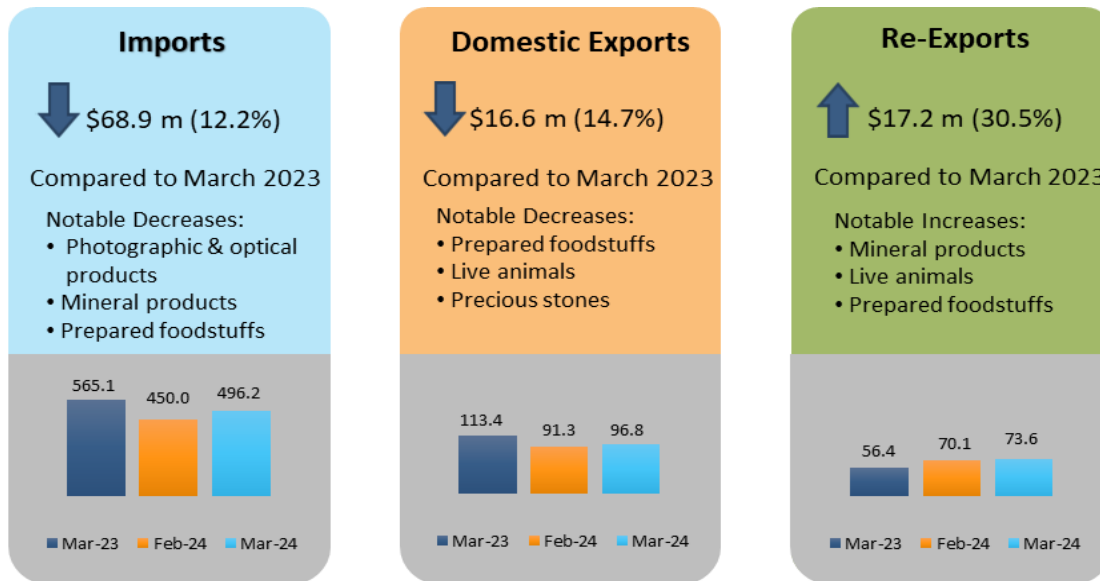


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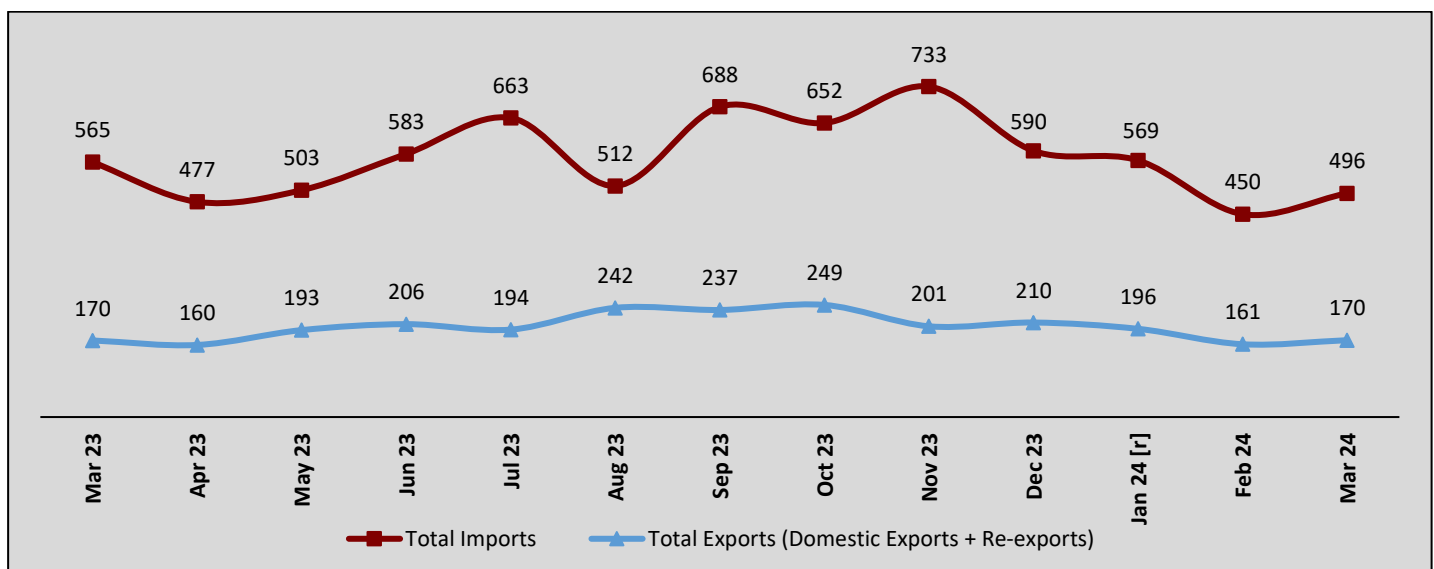
INTERNATIONAL MERCHANDISE TRADE STATISTICS March 2024

This International Merchandise Trade Statistics provides information on Fiji’s exports, re-exports and imports of goods between Fiji and the rest of the world. The administrative data used to compile this release is supplied by the Fiji Revenue and Customs Service (FRCS).



Note: The notable increases and decreases mentioned above relates to the IMTS Sections, refer to Tables 1-4. The values in the above charts are in millions and subject to rounding off.

Singapore

Decreased by \$18.9 million (14.6%) to \$110.5 million due to the decrease in imports of:

- Gas-oil (diesel);
- Aviation turbine fuel; and
- Light oils & preparations.

China – People’s Republic

Increased by \$9.1 million (11.9%) to \$86.1 million due to an increase in imports of:

- Other warships;
- Base stations; and
- Semi-milled or wholly milled rice.

New Zealand

Decreased by \$11.9 million (13.0%) to \$80.1 million due to the decrease in imports of:

- Milk in powder;
- Other semi-finished products of iron or non-alloy steel; and
- Other electric conductors.

Australia

Decreased by \$16.0 million (19.4%) to \$66.5 million due to the decrease in imports of:

- Liquefied butanes;
- Air humidifiers & dehumidifiers; and
- Other digital automatic data processing machines.

Thailand

Increased by \$12.8 million (98.5%) to \$25.7 million due to an increase in imports of:

- New dual-purpose vehicles;
- New passenger motor cars & racing cars; and
- New goods vehicles.

United States of America

Decreased by \$6.8 million (15.6%) to \$36.7 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Mineral waters & aerated waters;
- Other ginger; and
- Tunas.

Australia

Decreased by \$0.9 million (4.7%) to \$19.2 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Non-monetary gold;
- Women’s or girls’ garments of other textile materials; and
- Other garments knitted or crocheted.

New Zealand

Decreased by \$1.6 million (18.8%) to \$6.8 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Corned meat of bovine animals;
- Other beauty or make-up preparations; and
- Taro.

Samoa

Increased by \$1.5 million (32.0%) to \$6.2 million due to an increase in exports of:

- Flour;
- Other cane sugar; and
- Paints & varnishes based on acrylic or vinyl polymers.

Vanuatu

Decreased by \$3.9 million (43.5%) to \$5.1 million due to the decrease in exports of:

- Tunas;
- Corned meat of bovine animals; and
- Sausages.

Illustration 3: Re-Exports to Top 5 Major Destinations [FJD-Millions]

Tonga

Decreased by \$1.2 million (10.7%) to \$9.7 million due to the decrease in re-exports of:

- Gas-oil (diesel);
- Aviation turbine fuel; and
- Shampoos.

China – People’s Republic

Increased by \$1.3 million (30.7%) to \$5.4 million due to an increase in re-exports of:

- Tunas;
- Shipping containers; and
- Parts of electric sound or visual signaling apparatus.

Singapore

Increased by \$1.8 million (55.5%) to \$5.1 million due to an increase in re-exports of:

- Gas-oil (diesel);
- Light oils & preparations; and
- Other aerals & aerial reflectors.

United States of America

Increased by \$1.9 million (64.6%) to \$5.0 million due to an increase in re-exports of:

- Tunas;
- Other beauty or make-up preparations; and
- Pocket lighters.

American Samoa

Increased by \$3.1 million (261.8%) to \$4.2 million due to an increase in re-exports of:

- Tunas;
- Gas-oil(diesel); and
- Women’s or girls’ dresses of cotton.


